## Rosé

35% MERLOT, 33% SYRAH, 24% MALBEC,  
5% CARMENERE, 3% CABERNET FRANC

From dedicated blocks at Becker and Evernden Spring Vineyards, our Estate Rosé reflects the complexity that comes from our organic-certified terroirs in the Okanagan and Similkameen Valleys. The 2021 vintage is dry, finessed, and nuanced, with flavours of delicate red citrus, fresh berries, and layers of spice.

### The Vintage

The 2021 growing season was characterized by dry conditions, extreme heat, and small, concentrated berries.

Early budburst was followed by drier-than-average spring and summer. Favorable conditions at flowering resulted in good berry set. A one-in-a-thousand-year heat wave across the Pacific Northwest from late June to early July significantly impacted early berry development, resulting in small, concentrated berries.

Smoke from the Nk'Mip Creek fire reduced solar radiation on the valley floor in July and early August and delayed veraison. Conditions from veraison to harvest were optimal for the development of berry color, flavour, and tannin.
